

Part B Point of Sale Phase 2

Talking Points for MA Group Sales team

Summary: In 2021, Blue Cross is expanding the Part B POS project to boost member satisfaction and improve customer experience. Influenza (flu) and pneumococcal (pneumonia) vaccines are currently covered (this was phase 1 of the Part B POS project) and the phase 2 enhancement will add certain other Part B drugs such as oral cancer drugs and select nebulizer solutions for our MA only members. It will also add the hepatitis B vaccine and some oral antiemetics, antineoplastics and immunosuppressants for our MAPD members.

By early April for Medicare Plus Blue members and late May for BCN Advantage members, the aforementioned Part B drugs will be available for purchase at pharmacies with the appropriate coinsurance, deductible, and prior authorization without having to pay in full and submit a mail in medical claim reimbursement form (current process causing member dissatisfaction).

Who will be impacted?

Medicare Advantage PPO (MA & MAPD) & BCNA HMO groups including Key & Large: URMBT, MPSERS, SOM, UBR, etc.

In scope:

- Medicare Plus Blue PPO MA only (see exceptions noted below*) and MAPD
- BCNA (MA HMO, HMO-POS, MA PD) members
- Part B vs D drugs for MAPD members

Out of scope:

- Medicare Plus Blue PPO Prescription Drug Plan (PDP)
- Arkansas, Nebraska and Premera
- Part B vs D drugs for Medicare Plus Blue PPO MA only members*

* Medicare Plus Blue PPO MA only members are not eligible for coverage determinations on the B vs D list at this time.

What's changing?

- Part B drugs will be available for purchase at pharmacies with the appropriate coinsurance, deductible, and prior authorization without having to pay in full and submit a mail in medical claim reimbursement form (the current process was causing member dissatisfaction).
- Only vaccines are currently available. By early April for PPO and May for HMO-POS, many additional Part B drugs can be purchased at the pharmacy.

Benefit highlights

- How we're promoting this enhancement: Added ease & convenience for members you asked us for it, and we responded. One stop shopping for your Rx needs you'll no longer need to go to DME provider for select Part B drugs you can get everything at the same local pharmacy!
- We've expanded our Part B POS program for MA Members. Members will no longer have to submit a mail in medical claim reimbursement form for the drugs included in this enhancement.
- BCNA was already able to get some of these drugs at the pharmacy, now they can get all the drugs included in the enhancement this benefit is totally new to PPO.

What (if any) need to be taken by groups/agents/members

- MA Group Sales Reps will educate Groups/Agents about this expansion of Part B POS benefits
- Groups / Agents will need to educate members that these drugs can now obtained at the local pharmacy and that providers can prescribe a medication to the pharmacy now (they may need to write a new Rx)
- Note: this does not change existing prior authorization requirements

When the changes will go into effect?

Functionality will be available in Express Scripts / Part B Drugs available at the pharmacy.

PPO: 3/26/21*

BCNA: 5/13/21*

*The technical cutover for PPO is 3/26 and 5/13 for HMO. There's a week to confirm the activation and work out any Go Live issues. For PPO, we're targeting 4/2 (early April) for full implementation. For HMO, we're targeting 5/20 (late May) for full implementation.
